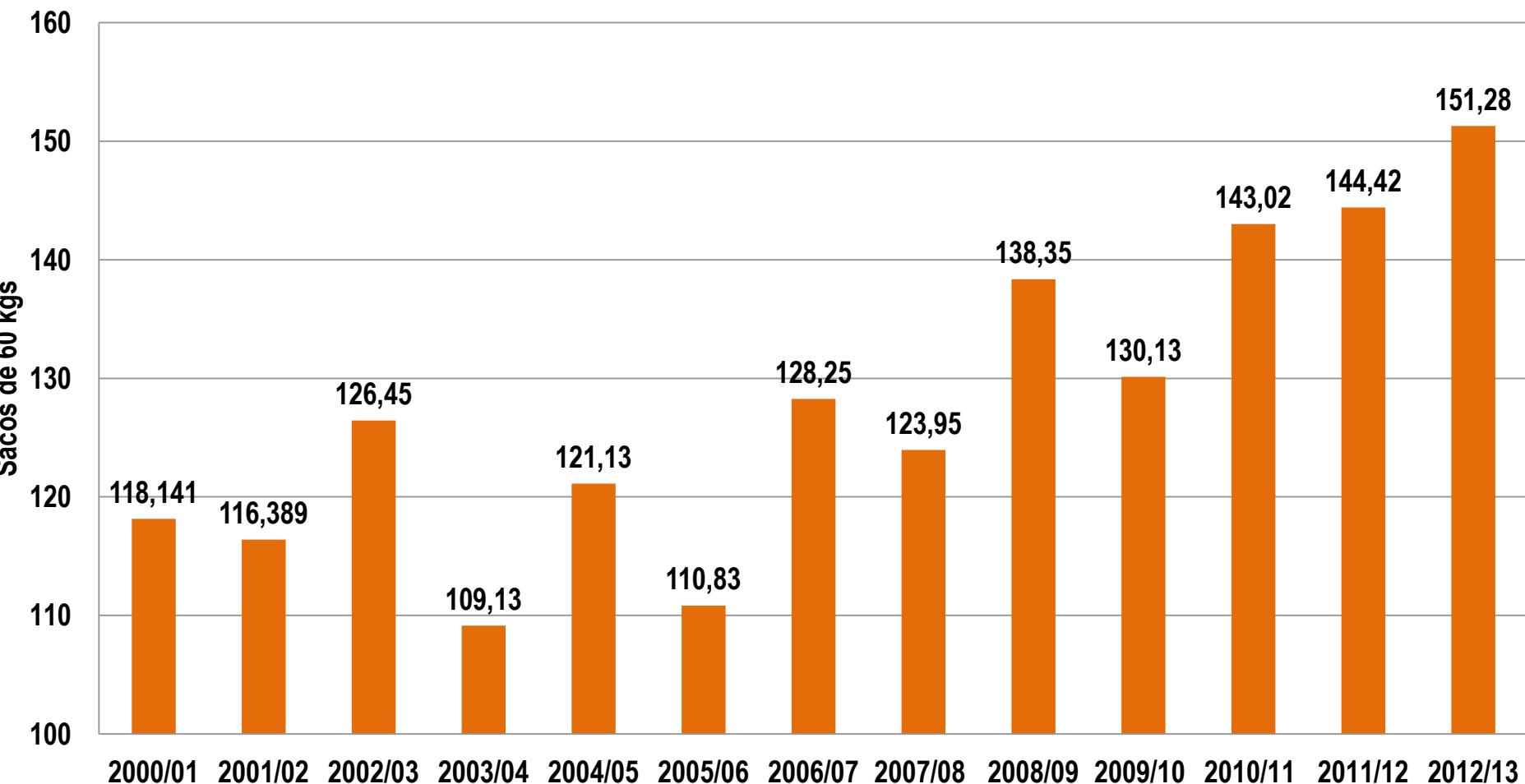


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Producción e importaciones de Café Verde en el Mundo y Europa

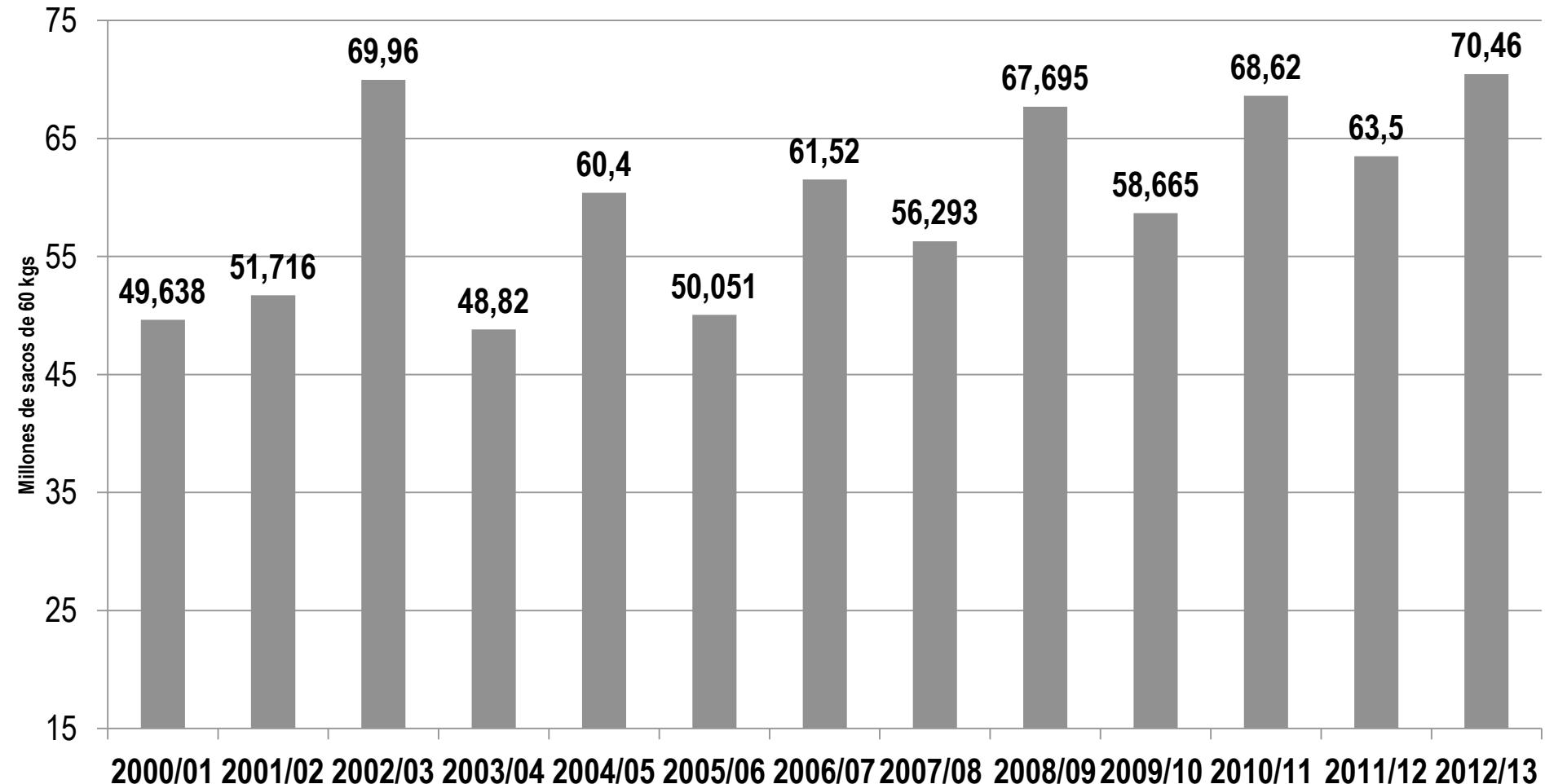


Evolucion de la produccion mundial (USDA)



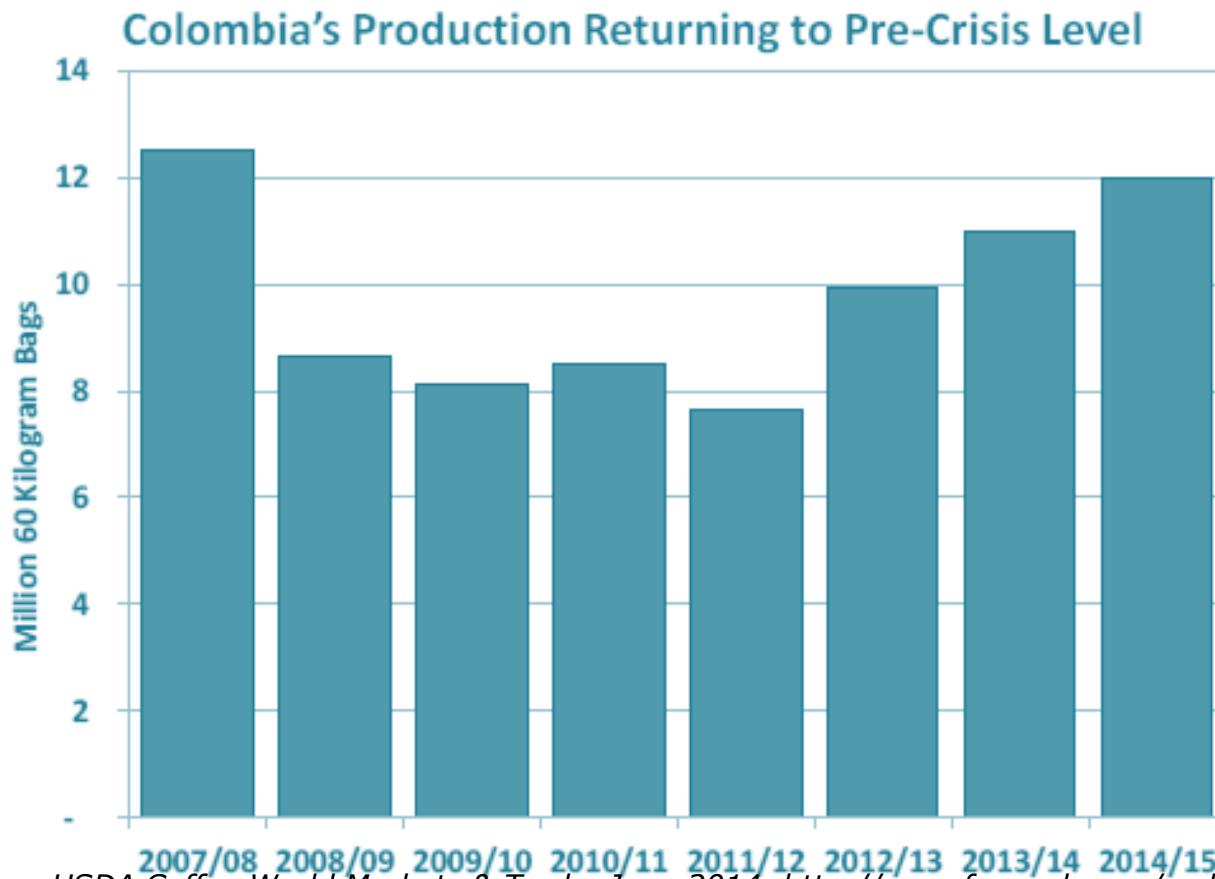


Evolución de la producción en America del Sur (USDA)





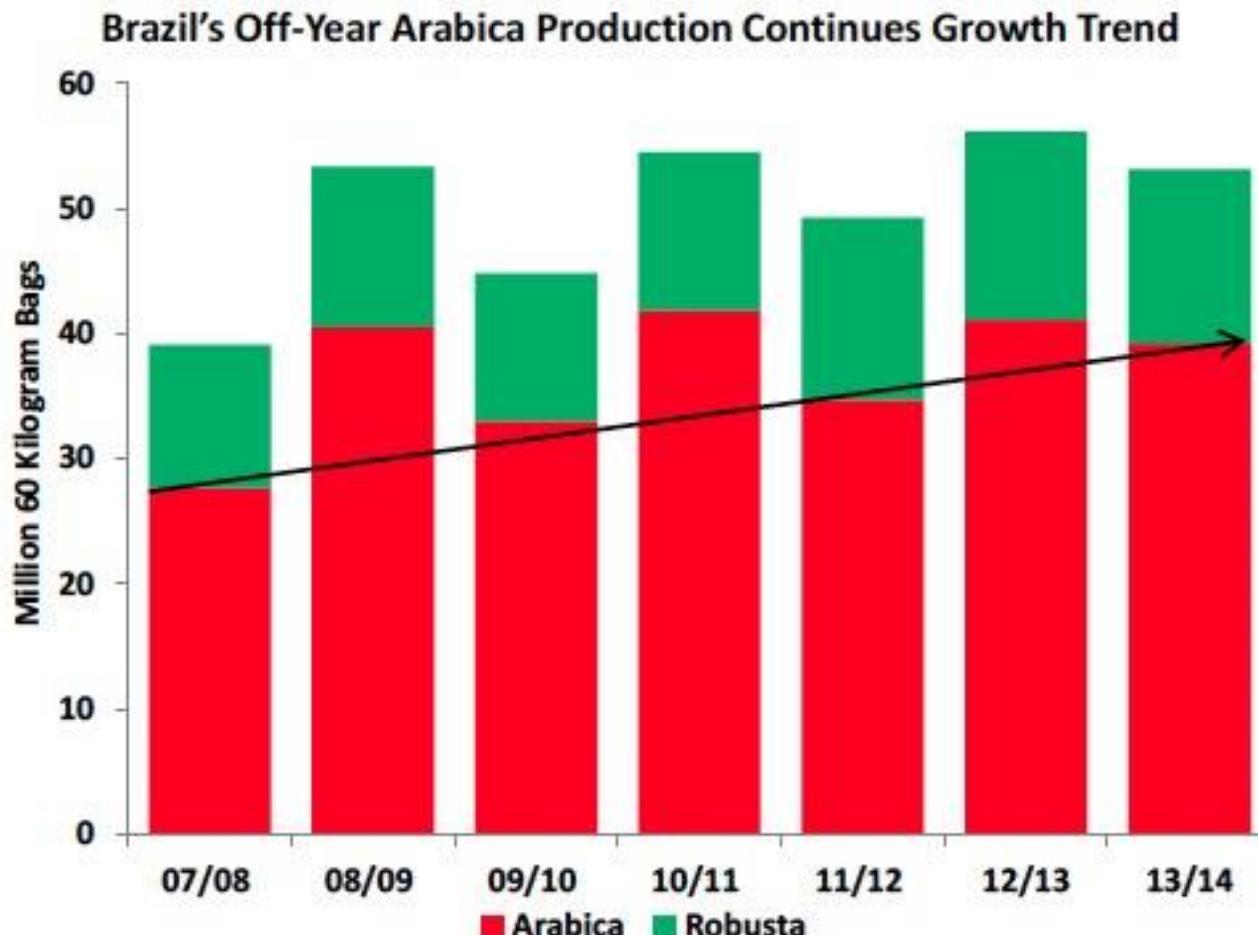
Producción de café verde en Colombia (con est. 14/15)

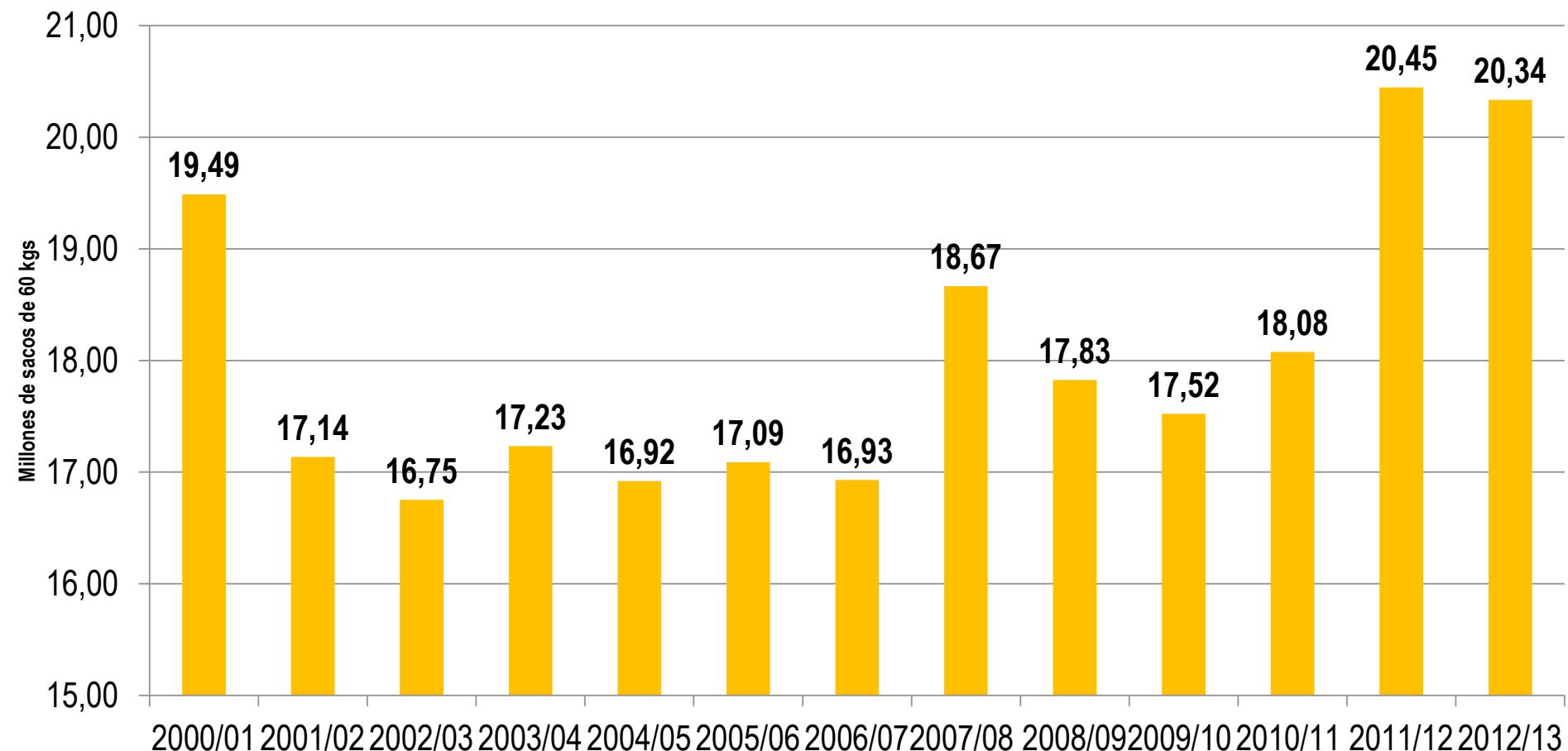


Evolución de la producción en Brasil (USDA)



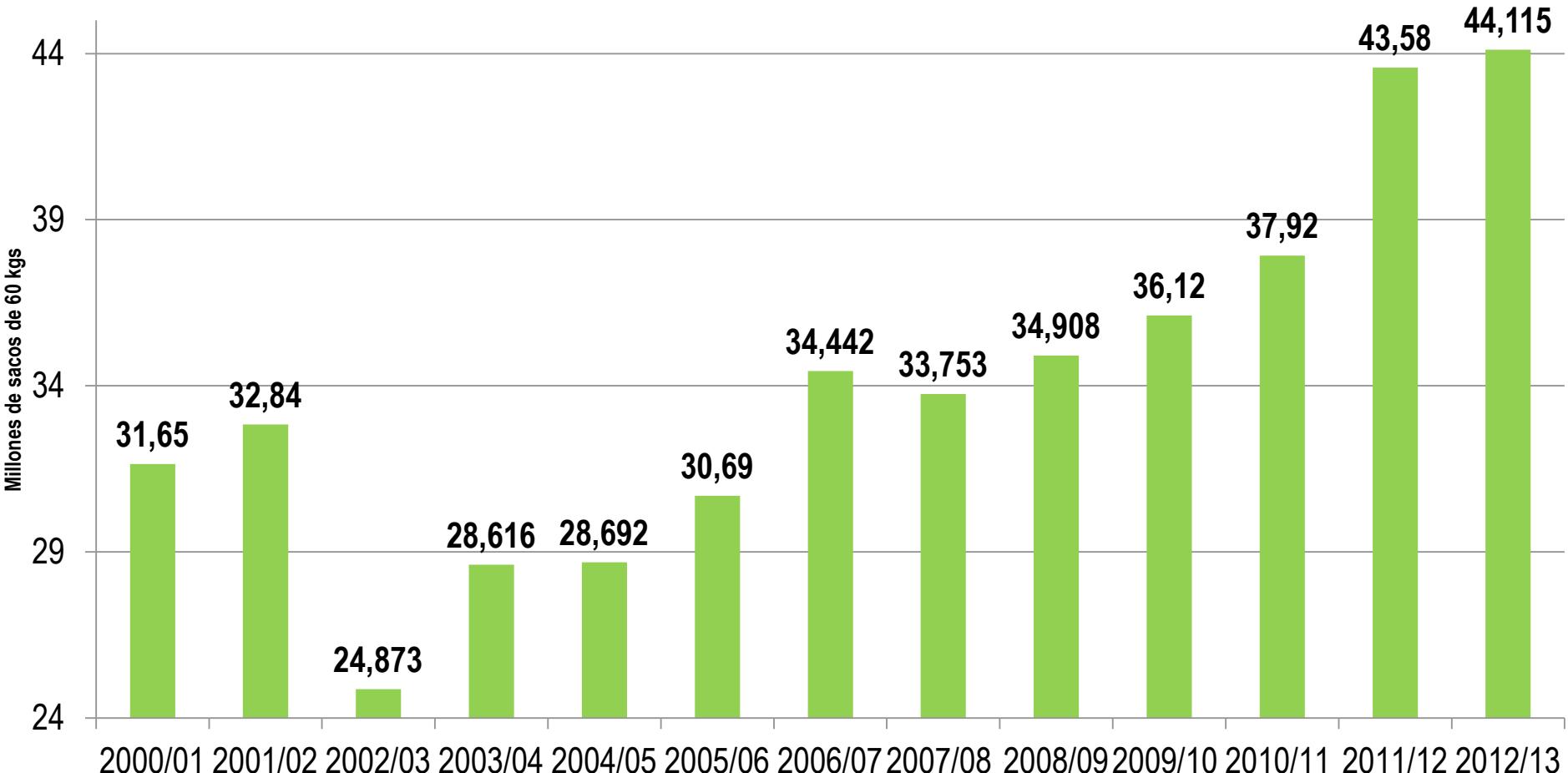


Evolucion de la producción en Centroamérica



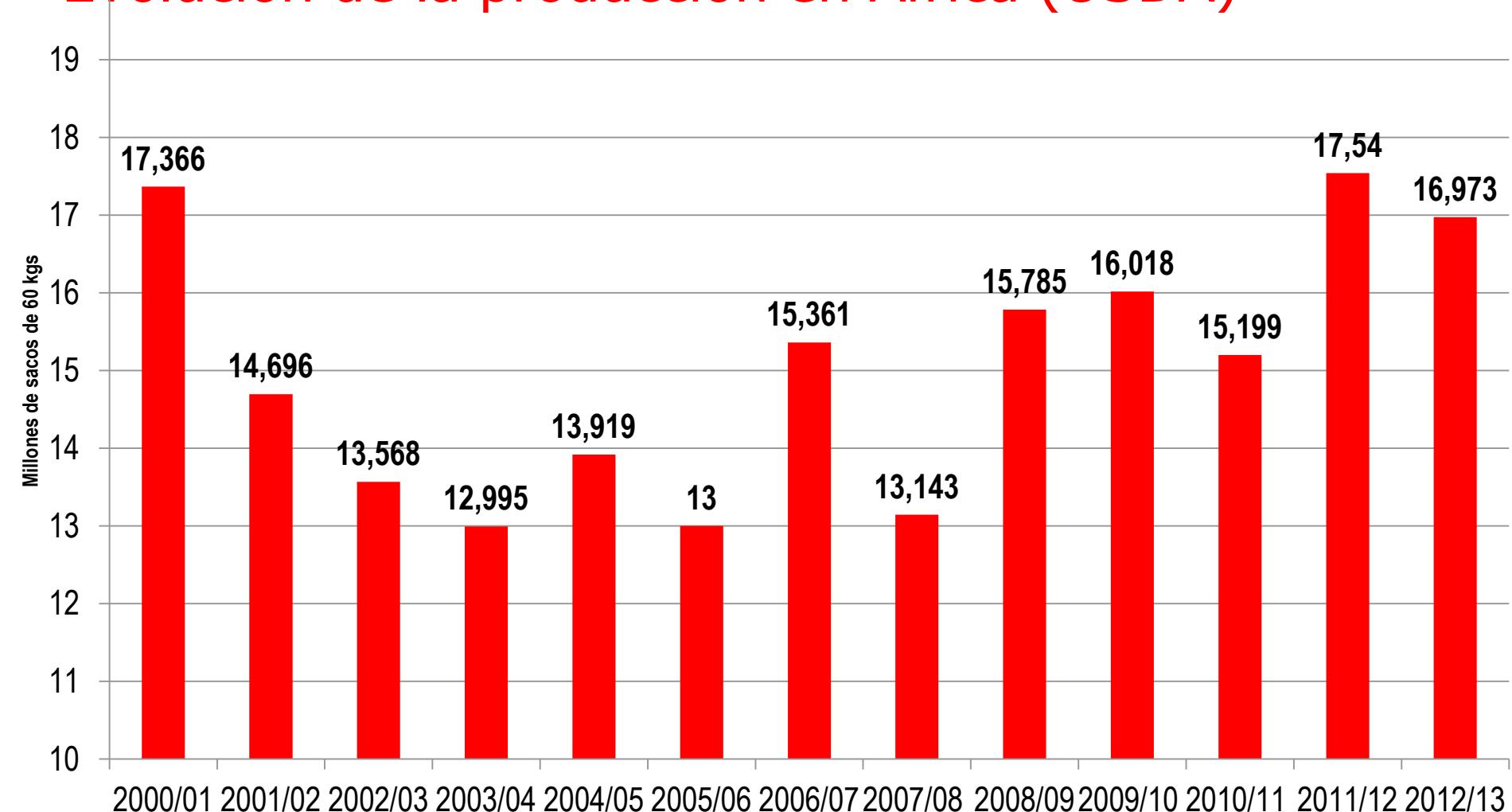


Evolución de la producción en Asia (USDA)



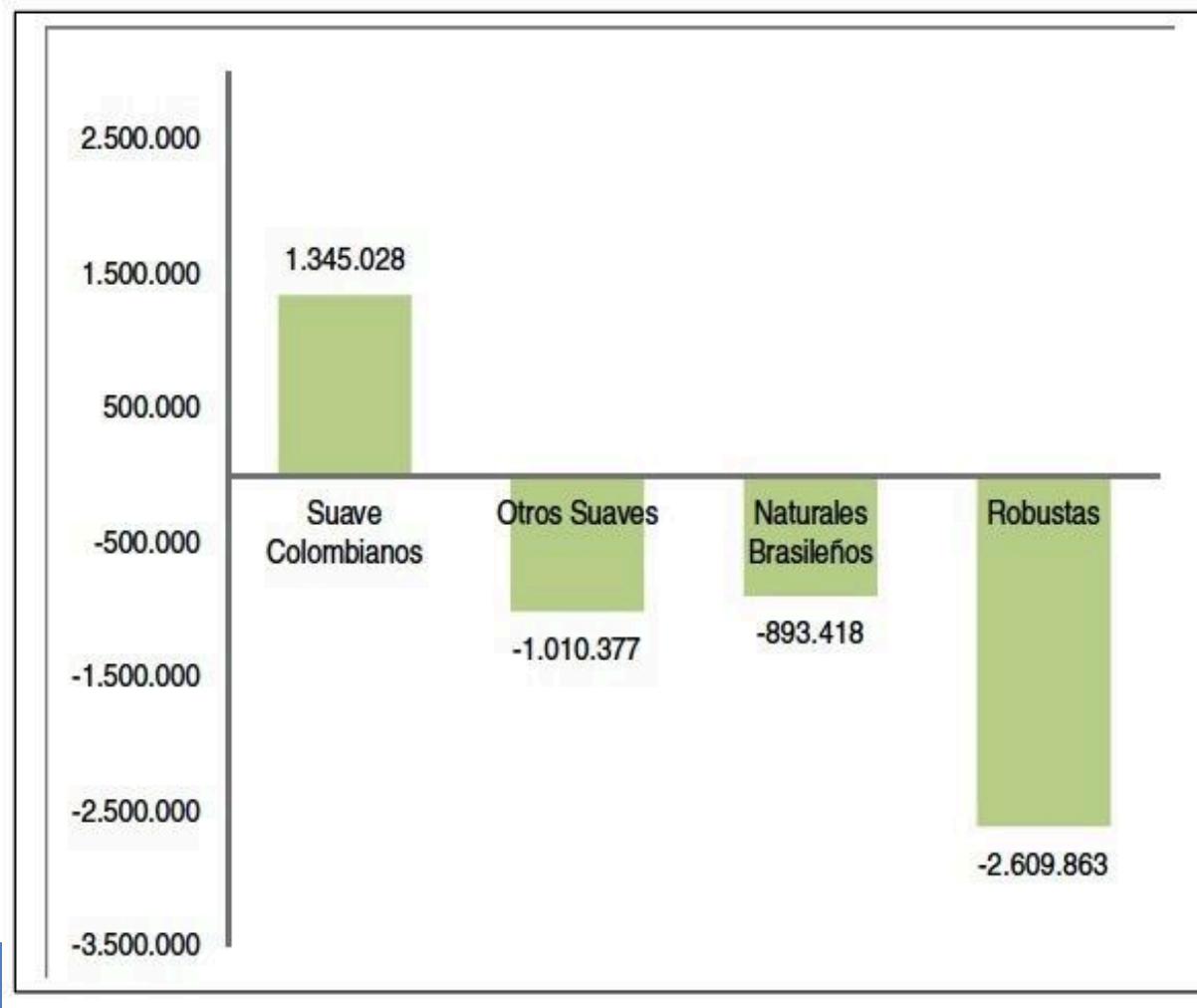


Evolución de la producción en África (USDA)

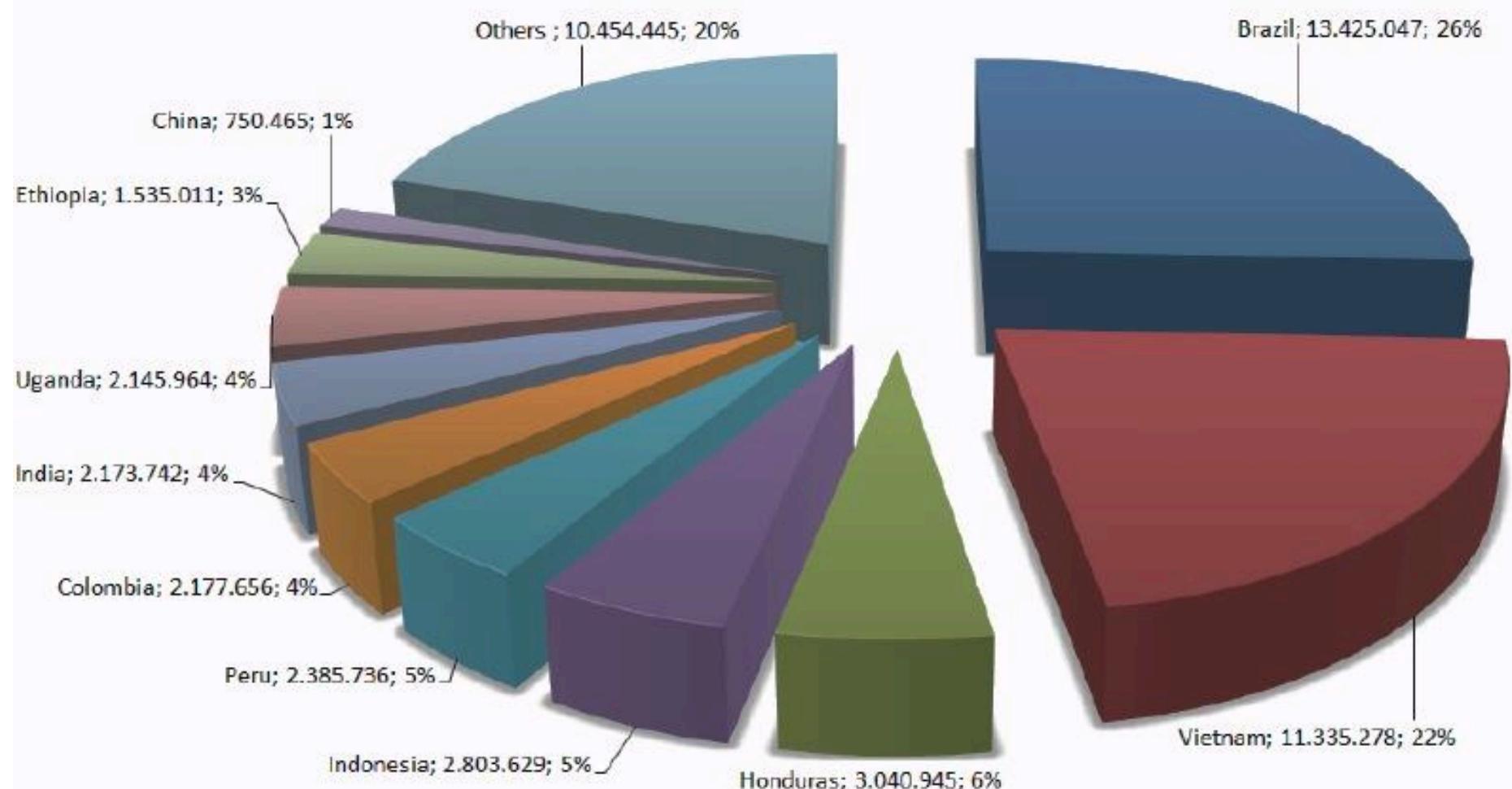

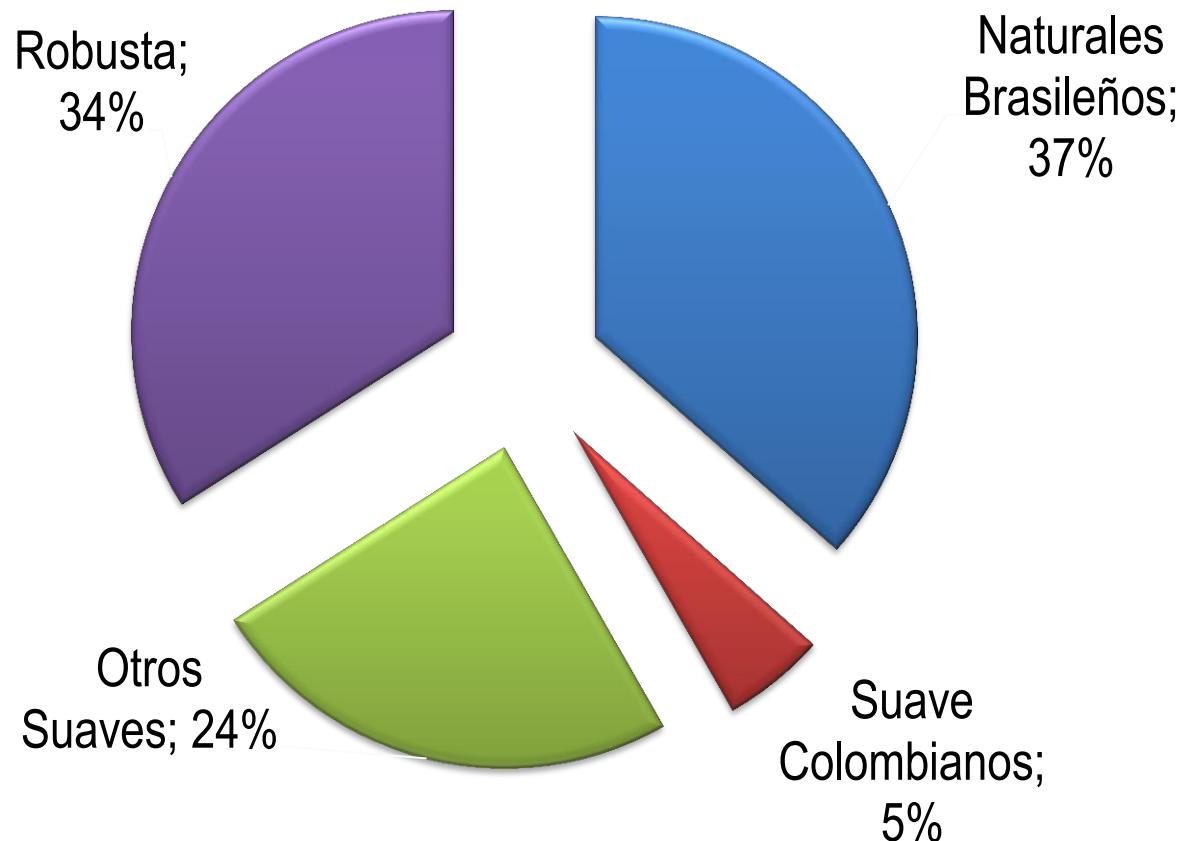




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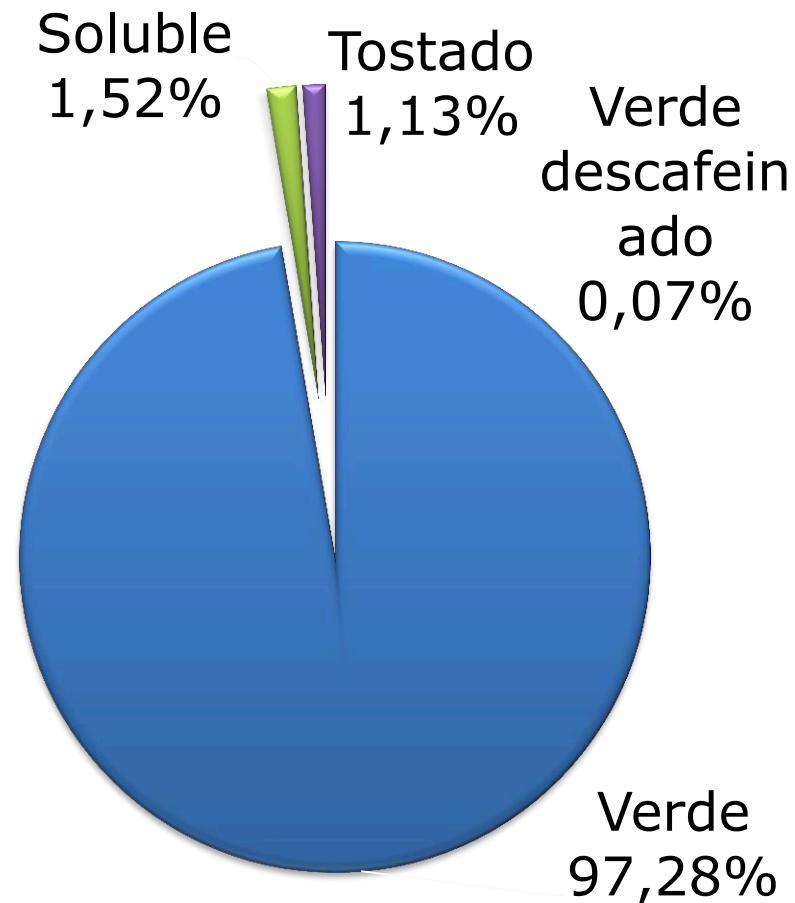
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Importación café verde por tipo

- Almacenamiento y 'handling' en Europa lo considera caro

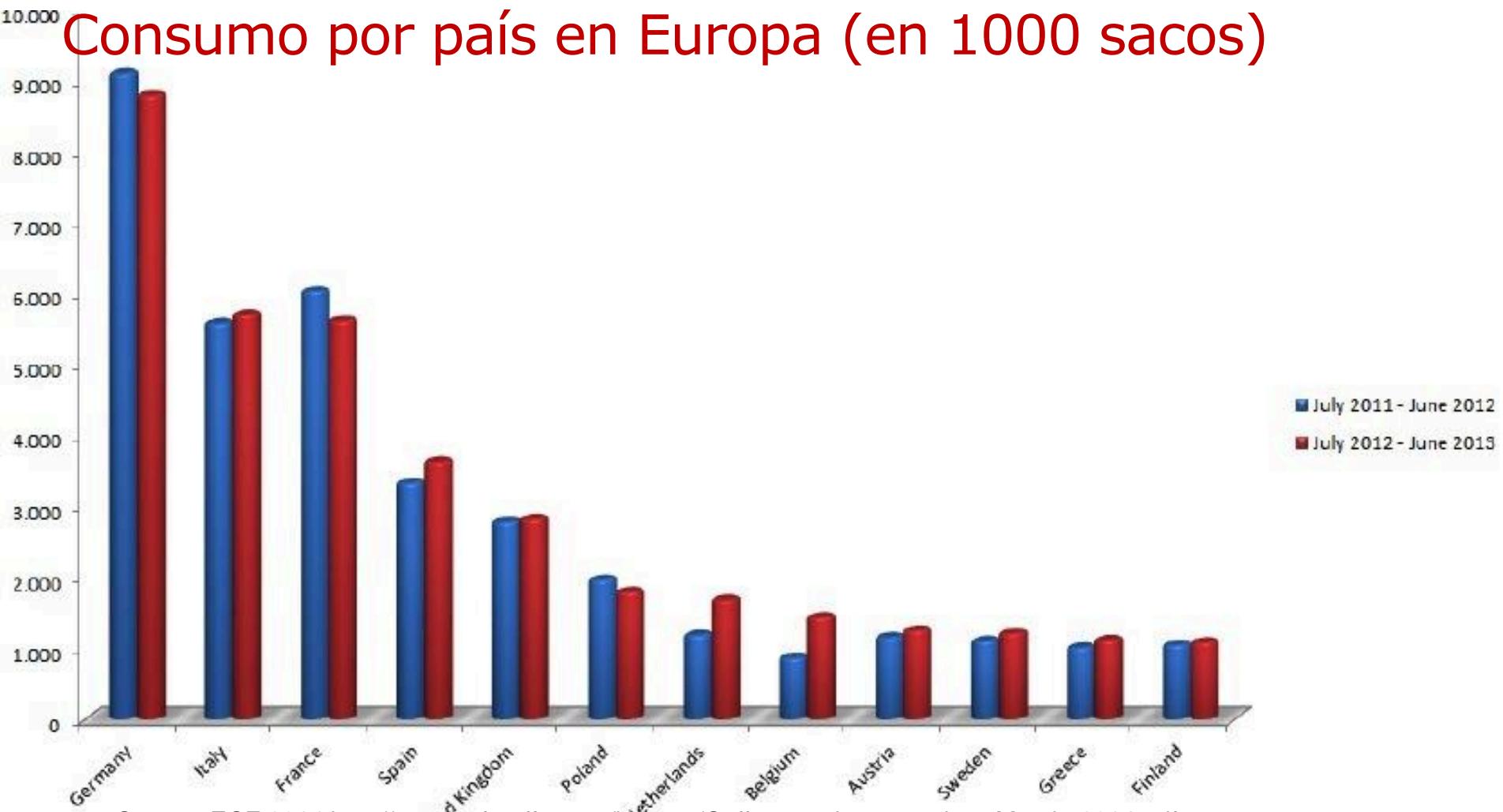

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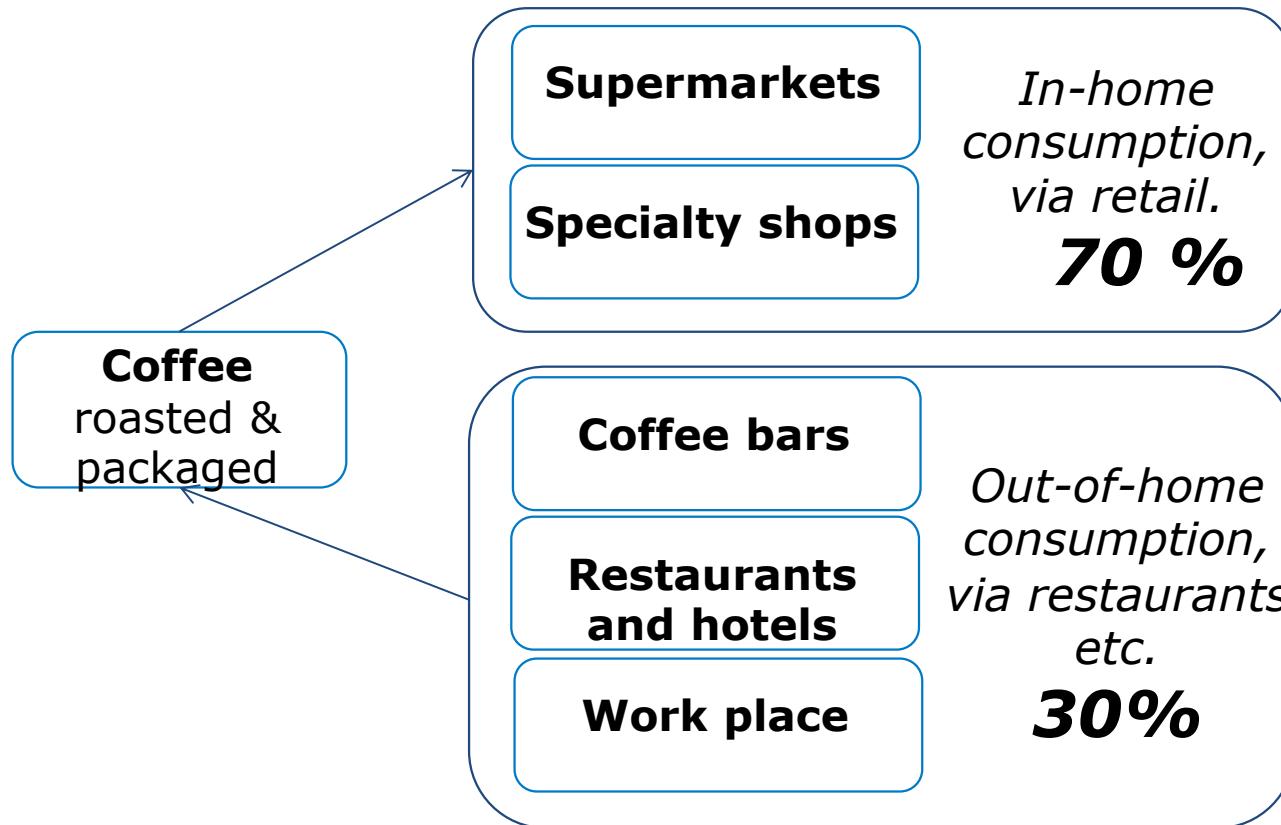

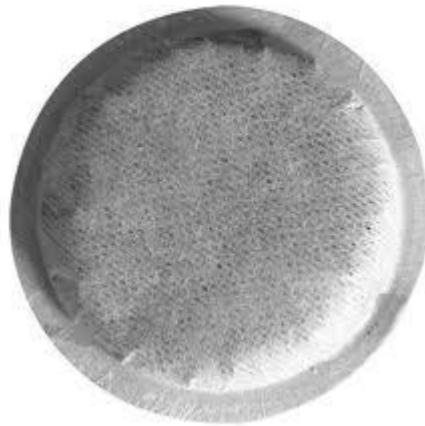

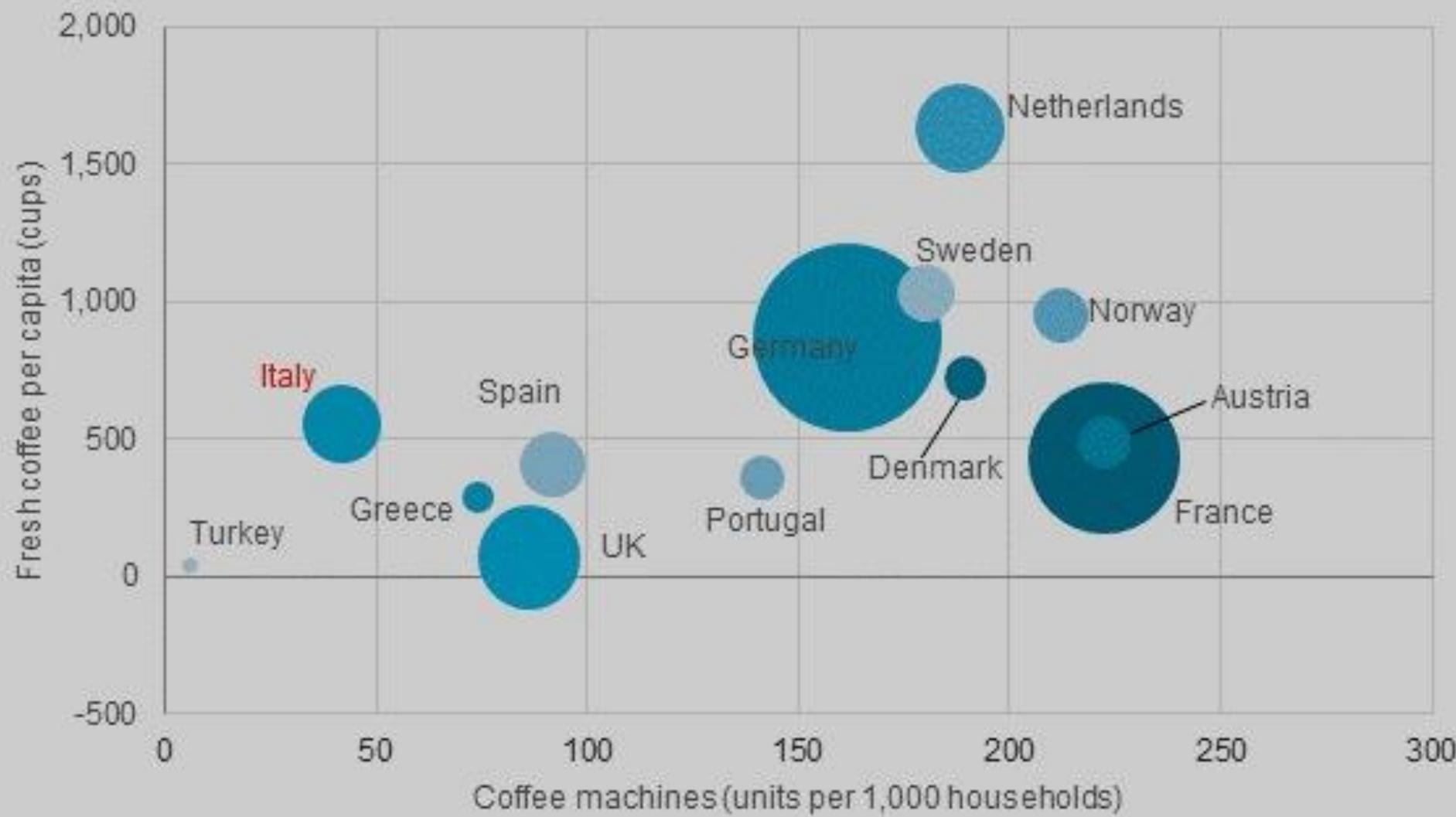

3.5 tlds café tostado de "Países en Vía de Desarrollo" (= países productores de café) (€16 millón)

(426.000 tlds soluble).

Por qué tan difícil?

- Tostaduría bien establecida y una industria importante en la UE
- A veces más aranceles para café tostado
- Desafíos logísticos para almacenaje, envíos
- Requerimientos de consistencia en calidad y seguridad alimenticia
- Desafíos de marketing / mucha competencia

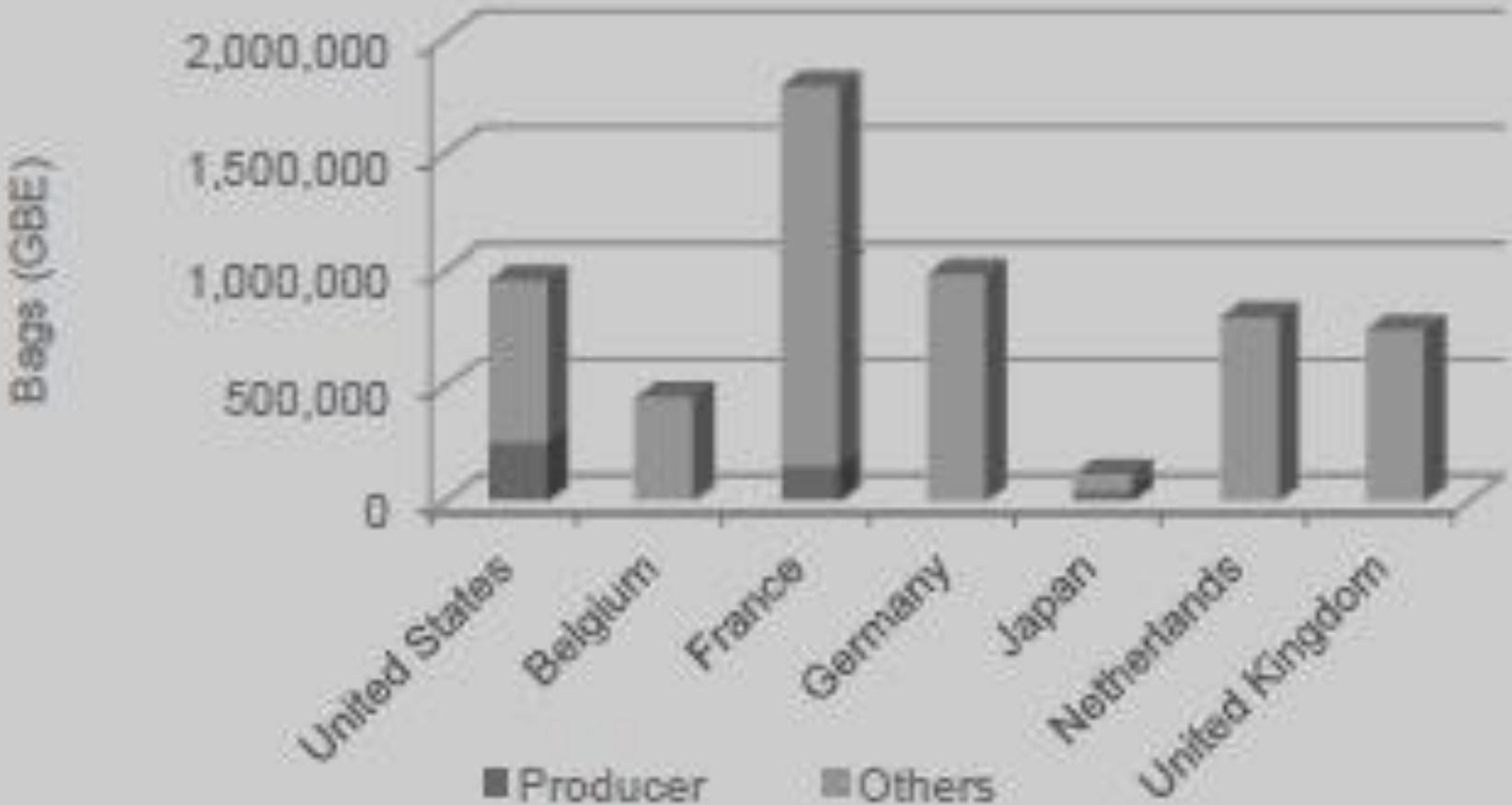

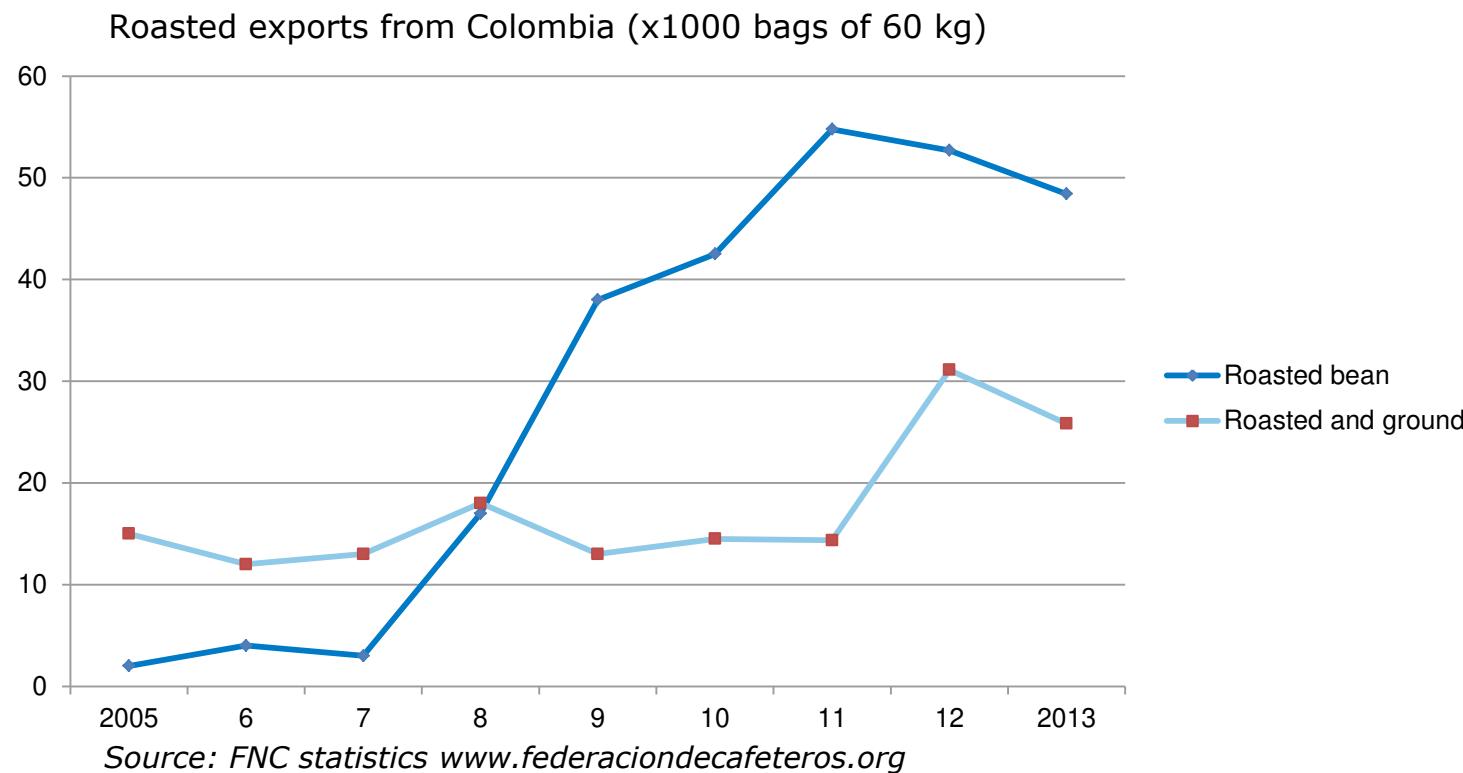

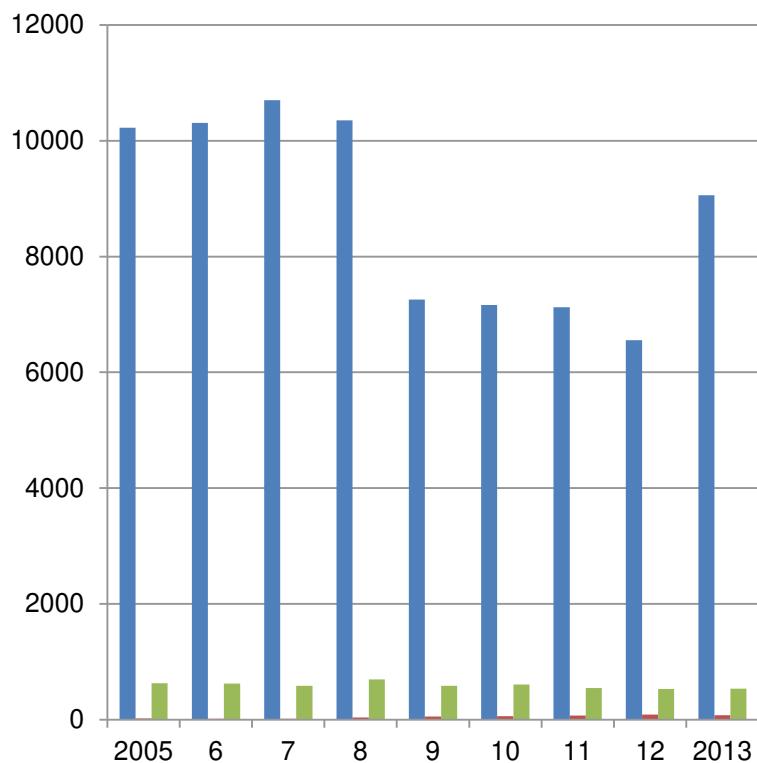

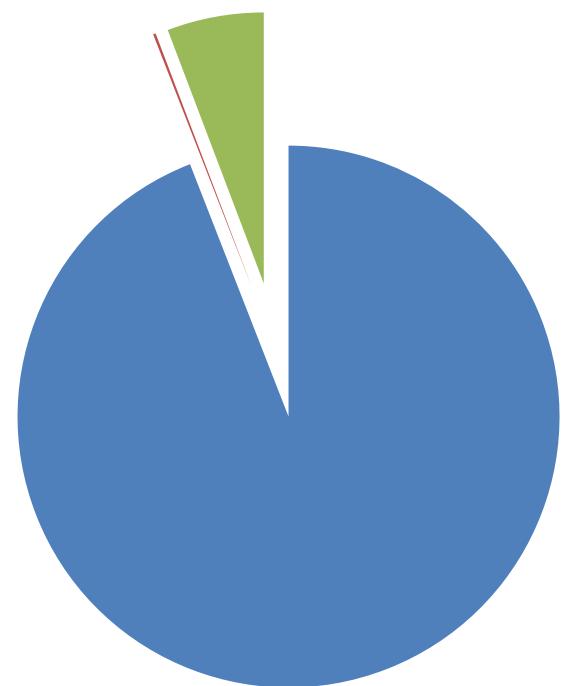




Exportaciones colombianas: café verde, tostado y soluble (x 1000 de sacos de 60 kg) (11% de la producción de Arabigo)

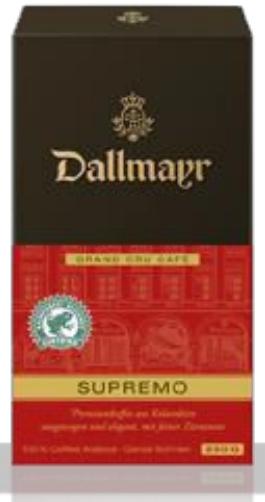
